Sinchana Foundation Impact Assessment (2021–24)

1. Background

- Founded in 2014 in Bengaluru by Ms. Charitha Kudige, Special Educator.
- Focus: Therapy, education, and holistic development of children with Autism, ADHD, genetic syndromes, and intellectual disabilities.
- Vision: Enable independent living for children with special needs.

2. Core Programs Assessed

• One-on-One Therapy Program (OOP):

- Personalized sessions for ages 2–8.
- o Focus on speech, cognition, language, play, and developmental milestones.

• School Program (SP):

- Academic instruction for slow learners and children with learning disabilities.
- Karnataka State Syllabus + functional academics (math, literacy, life skills).
- Includes group activities, games, origami, exposure visits, and celebrations.

3. Methodology

- Conducted by Own2Feet Association (O2F).
- Mixed methods: telephonic/virtual interviews with parents, staff, and founder.
- Census-based approach (small beneficiary pool).
- Stakeholders: Parents, children, supervisors, interventionists.

4. Key Findings

• Child Development:

- \circ 86% (SP) and 90% (OOP) parents reported significant progress in children.
- o Improvements in speech, reading, writing, cognition, and social skills.

• Parent Quality of Life (QOL):

- Parents reported increased awareness, confidence, and ability to manage child needs.
- o High satisfaction with program delivery and professionalism of staff.

• Mainstreaming:

o 3 children successfully transitioned into regular schools.

• Interventionists:

Parents rated staff as knowledgeable and professional.

o On-the-job training effective, but need for structured training modules.

• Infrastructure:

- o Current facilities inadequate compared to quality of interventions.
- o Larger, improved space required.

• Parent Counseling:

• Informal counseling exists; structured program recommended for better engagement.

5. Challenges

- Limited infrastructure and space.
- Need for more comprehensive staff training.
- Societal barriers and stigma around disability.

6. Recommendations

- Develop a **strategic blueprint** for scaling services.
- Strengthen infrastructure and expand reach.
- Introduce structured parent counseling programs.
- Regular training workshops for interventionists.
- Enhance extracurricular and physical activities for children.

7. Overall Impact

- Both programs (SP & OOP) are **meeting objectives**:
 - o Improving developmental progress in children.
 - Enhancing family quality of life.
- Parents express high satisfaction with interventions and delivery.
- Sinchana Foundation is well-positioned to scale up and strengthen services.
